The last Sunday of the year, Kristin Beane played her flute for a celebrated children's service. Now, 2007 arrives and starts Epiphany with classical music of J. S. Bach, Flor Peters, Felix Mendelssohn and many others.

In February, look for the **Music Notes** section of **The Messenger**. It will feature information on Dietrich Buxtehude (1637-1707), a Dane/German composer who lived during the Baroque period. J. S. Bach once traveled over 200 miles to hear Buxtehude play and stayed for three months. (Doesn't sound like a vacation!) His music still is studied and sung by choral groups, chamber musicians and organists 300 years after his death.
